

## HAHOE VILLAGE AREA

**I Hahoe Village** **UNESCO World Heritage**

Hahoe gained its name because of the Nakdong River that flows through the local village. Dongseong Village of the Punghcheon clan. It is the best place to understand traditional culture, since buildings from the early Joseon Dynasty and the folk culture of Hahoe byelsoingut tanoon and the firework boat festival still remain. UNESCO registered Hahoe Village as a World Heritage in 2010 due to its outstanding universal value as cultural heritage of mankind.

**I Bouyongdae Cliff**

The strangely shaped cliffs and the flowing river form a picturesque scene, and the view of Hahoe Village from the top reveals a sense of mystery.

**Hominji Reservoir** Galleon-ri, Punghcheon-myeon, Andong-si



The presence of the 330,000m<sup>3</sup> Hominji Reservoir has created a good hiking trail along the 3.2km Dulle-gil.

**I Byeongsan Seowon** **UNESCO World Heritage**

Byeongsan Seowon, built in 1572 (the 5th year of King Seonjo) by Seoae Hyu Seong-nyong, features buildings placed to embrace the magnificent surrounding mountains. Mandeu is the pinnacle of harmonization with nature, demonstrating excellence in garden architecture. In recognition of its architectural beauty and outstanding universal value, it was registered as a World Heritage Site in 2019.

**I Gail Village** Gail-gil, Punghcheon-myeon, Andong-si



As a place where the original traditional village form is well preserved, there are many things to see here such as Gagokgi, the Confucius and Culture Museum, and old houses such as the Byeonggok Heed House of the last family of the Andong Kwon Gail clan, as well as Sugok Old House and Namcheon Old House.

**Chehwaejeong Pavilion** Sangni-ri, Pungsan-eup, Andong-si



This pavilion was built in 171 by Lee Minjeok in the late Joseon dynasty, and visitors can enjoy its beauty throughout all four seasons as different flowers bloom.

Wolyeonggyo Bridge, the largest wooden bridge in Korea, has very beautiful night lights. Fountains are installed on both sides of the bridge to spout refreshing water. It is said that if one takes a picture at the octagonal pavilion in the center of Wolyeonggyo Bridge, the wish will come true.

**I Nakdong River Music Fountain** Nakdong Riverside in Andong



The Nakdong River Music Fountain, which is 20m high and 30m wide, satisfies the five senses of onlookers who visit not only for the high shooting fountain but also the laser shows of straight and curved lines that harmonize with sweet music.

Up a little further after passing the rest area in the forest are some steps leading to Andongru, where visitors can see the view of Andong Dam at a glance.

The birthplace of Seok-ju Lee Sang-nyong, who served as the first Prime Minister of the Provisional Government in Shanghai. He established the Sinheung Military Academy, laid the foundation for the armed independence movement, and practiced 'noblesse oblige'.

This is a healing box in the city center where visitors can see the city of Andong at a glance and feel the unique sensibility of the moon village.

Toegye Yi Hwang, one of Korea's greatest Confucian scholars, known as Heodong Jwa, built the Dosan Seowon where he educated Confucian scholars and conducted his own studies. After he passed away, this seowon was built by his students in Yum to commemorate their teacher's virtue.

**I Yiyuksa Literary Museum**

Opened to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the birth of Yiyuksa, the Yiyuksa Literary Museum displays his manuscripts as well as his poetry collections and materials related to the independence movement. In addition, the teacher's birthplace and the green grape springs have been restored around the museum.

**I Toegye Jongtaek** **Gyeongju-Do Monument No. 42**

In 1923, the 13th generation of Toegye Yi Hwang's descendants restored the house to its original scale. It has 6 sections in the front and 5 sections on the sides in the shape of a square building, with a tall gate in the front.

**I Korean Studies Institute** **UNESCO World Heritage**



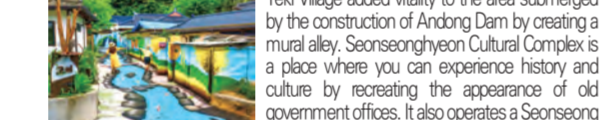
Established as a non-profit foundation under the Ministry of Culture, Sports, and Tourism in 1995 for the purpose of creative succession of traditional culture through comprehensive and systematic research and study of traditional cultural heritage, along with education and dissemination of traditional values. The Confucian Printing Woodblocks were created by scholars in the Joseon Dynasty to print and publish their works. Out of about 305 manuscripts, 710 types and 84,226 sub-items were donated as kept in storage, and they were registered as UNESCO World Heritage in 2015.

**I Seonbi Walking Path** Dosan-myeon, Andong-si, Gyeongju-Do



It consists of 9 courses made up of 58km of walking trails along the waterside of Andongho Lake. Visitors will encounter beautiful natural scenery, as well as Seodang, Seowon, Hyanggyo, and old houses, and find traces of old scholars, including Toegye Yi Hwang.

**I Yeki Village & Seonseonghyun Cultural Heritage Complex**

Yeki Village added vitality to the area surrounded by the construction of Andong Dam by creating a mural alley. Seonseonghyun Cultural Complex is a place where you can experience history and culture by recreating the appearance of old government offices. It also operates a Seonseong wayway walking on the lake and a hanok experience center, an accommodation facility.

**I Gosanjeong Pavilion** **Tangible Cultural Property No. 274**

Located under Gosonghyup, one of the Eight Views of Andong, Obyeongsan and Naebyeongsan Mountains surround the Gosanjeong like traditional folding screens, and the Dosan Mountain and the pine forest rise across the Gosanjeong upstream of the Nakdonggyo River to create a superb view.

**I World Confucianism Seonbi Cultural Park**

World Confucianism Seonbi Cultural Park is a LAROHIVUM (a compound world of library, archive, and museum) that gathers knowledge and information of the Confucianism mindset and civilizations from around the world. There are various exhibition facilities and a 4-sided LED Media Art Tower with a total length of 16m.

**I Kwon Jeong Saeng Fairy Tale Museum**

The Kwon Jeong Saeng Fairy Tale Museum is a place that captures the literature and life of the late teacher Kwon Jeong-saeng, who dreamed of a peaceful world for children. Visitors can see works and relics left by Kwon Jeong-saeng, and there are accommodation facilities for group visitors.

**I Kwon Jeong-saeng's Birthplace** 57-12, Jintaeon-gil, Iljik-myeon, Andong-si

The birthplace of Kwon Jeong-saeng (1937-2007), a famous writer of children's literature, which holds the traces of his life. During his lifetime, he wrote over 100 fairy tales such as 'Dog Poop' and 'Mongil Sister', and taught children that 'there is not a single useless existence in the world'.

**I Amsan Pleasure Ground** 59, Amsan 1-gil, Namhu-myeon, Andong-si

A river boated under the natural habitat of oriental aborigine in Gu-ri (Natural Monument No. 252) where visitors can enjoy romantic boat rides in the summer and skate in the winter, when the Amsan Ice Festival is held here.

**I Gyeongsangbuk-do Independence Movement Memorial Hall**

A center for patriotic education that passes down and develops the merits and mindsets of independence activists, highlighting the history of the independence movement in Andong, the holy land of the movement that produced the largest number of patriots in the country.

**I Manhyujeong Pavilion** **Gyeongju-Do Cultural Heritage Material No. 170**  
 42, Mukgyehar-gil, Gilan-myeon, Andong-si

This pavilion was built in 1500 by Bobaekdang Kim Gye-heang, who was a civil minister in the early Joseon Dynasty. It consists of 3 sections in the front and 2 sections on the side, and the front is open in the form of a nuruso so that visitors can enjoy the natural scenery, and onid rooms are placed on both sides to be used as academic spaces.

**I Mukgye Seowon** **Gyeongju-Do Folklore Cultural Property No. 16**

A seowon dedicated to Bobaekdang Kim Gye-heang and Eung-gyo Okgo, who were scholars in the Joseon Dynasty. Founded during the reign of Joseon King Sukjong, it is also a place with a peaceful history as it had to be restored after being demolished by Heungseon Daewon-gun's decree to demolish Seowons.

**I Yonggye Ginkgo Tree**

A giant tree that is estimated to be about 700 years old, reaching a height of 37m. According to legend, Prince Tak Sun-chang, who served as a training commander during the reign of King Sejo of the Joseon dynasty, came back to his hometown after the Japanese invasion of Korea and formed a guild to protect this tree, under whose shade he enjoyed chatting.

Bongjeongsa Temple, the oldest wooden structure in Korea, as well as Daesungon Hall, Hwaesongpangjak Lecture Hall, and Gogamsudang Hall built during the Joseon Dynasty, and serves as valuable material for architectural studies. There are a three-story stone pagoda built in the Goryeo Dynasty, buildings such as Mansaeu and Yosaeche, and small attached temples such as Yeonsaram and Jipsam. At the 42nd World Heritage Committee in June 2018, seven temples including Bongjeongsa were registered as UNESCO World Heritage sites under the umbrella of 'Sansa, Buddhist Mountain Monasteries in Korea'.

**I Icheon-dong Ma-ae-yeorae Ipsang** **Treasure No. 15**

A rock-carved Buddha from the Goryeo Dynasty, called 'Jebwion Maltreay', carved on a granite stone wall with a 10m-high body and a 2.5m-high head.

## ANDONG SPECIALTIES

**I Andongpo**  
 Andongpo, one of the best fabrics for clothes due to the influence of climate and soil quality, was presented to the royal court in the past as a hemp cloth with thin, yellowish threads. It is produced in Geumso-ri in Imha-myeon and has been designated as Gyeongju-Do Intangible Cultural Heritage No. 1.

**I Andong Hanji**  
 Andong Poongsan Hanji, which boasts world-class quality, is made with the traditional method of using natural Korean mulberry wood as the raw material, and has excellent absorbency and divergence, being used as window paper, wallpaper, hiveson paper, and for crafts.

**I Hahoe Mask**  
 These masks are made by cutting from alder trees, coating with paper, and coloring and lacquering them. It was used during Byelsoingut, and there are 11 terms of 10 kinds.

**I Andong Soju**  
 This folk wine was made using grain liquor made three times from rice and has been handed down from a famous family in Andong. This folk wine, characterized by distillation, is designated as Gyeongju-Do Intangible Cultural Property No. 12.

**I Andong Salted Mackerel**  
 The name is derived from the fact that seafood from Yeongbuk was brought to Andong to be sold, and it is made by adding salt to fresh mackerel caught in the southeastern coastal waters.

**I Andong Heotjesatbap**  
 Following the Andong custom of eating bibimbap as food to eat after performing ancestral rites, the bibimbap is prepared with those same ingredients.

**I Andong Jjimdak**  
 Chicken, glass noodles, and vegetables such as potatoes, spinach, and green onion harmonize to create a delicious combination of spicy, sweet, and light tastes.

**I Andong Korean Beef**  
 Andong Korean beef, born overseas raised with a unique breeding method in a clear and clean natural environment, is high-quality meat with unique taste and small cut to the even distribution of fat throughout the meat.

**I 264 Green Grape Wine**  
 With a rich fruity flavor and refreshing acidity that goes well with Korean food, this is a wine with favorable reviews that has passed the wine manufacturing and aging technology test and quality test.

**I Andong Ginger Extract**  
 Andong ginger, grown with the fertile energy of Andong, continues to be produced through the skill of Andong nobility. It boasts the highest quality, being processed using 100% undiluted ginger solution.
